BY ALERTING AUTHORITIES TO THEFT & SECURITY INCIDENTS YOU CAN HELP

- Better preserve the integrity of your supply chain
- Safeguard your workplace
- Protect your company's reputation
- Strengthen the efforts of law enforcement agencies to fight organised crime

IF ANY INCIDENT OCCURS

- Inform your manager of the incident immediately
- Your company should report incidents promptly
- All details should be noted (registration of vehicles, people involved, time and dates) and nothing should be removed from the scene

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

TO REPORT THEFT

- If you want to report theft but have no evidence of where and when it occurred **VISIT WWW.AFP.GOV.AU/FORMS**
- If you have evidence of an incident that occurred at Sydney Airport **CALL AFP ON 131 237**
- If you have evidence of an incident that occurred outside of Sydney Airport **CALL NSW POLICE FORCE ON 131 444**

TO REPORT SECURITY INCIDENTS OTHER THAN THEFT

- If you witnessed an incident at Sydney Airport **CALL AFP ON 131 237**
- If you witnessed an incident outside of Sydney Airport **CALL CRIME STOPPERS ON 1800 333 000**
- If you suspect smuggling activities **CALL CUSTOMS ON 1800 06 1800**

IN ALL CASES

- Your information will be passed on to the relevant operational areas for immediate response or possible investigation
- All the information you provide will remain confidential
