



Easy Payment of Terminal Fees

Please be advised that effective immediately AaE International now offers the choice for all freight forwarders to remit Cargo Handling terminal fees via the “CASS Import & Terminal Charge” settlement system (similar to export shipments with airlines).

AaE and IATA CASS have successfully conducted a pilot trial with the assistance of Mainfreight International.

The process and timeframes are exactly the same as the IATA CASS Export settlement system and allows more transactions to be remitted electronically via IATA CASS, simplifying the payment process for your organisation.

Some relevant facts are:

- there is no charge for using this facility from either IATA or AaE
- there is no additional financial securities required by IATA
- dedicated CASS Billing Report and Remittance (separate from CASS Export)
- companies can continue to receive their invoice daily or weekly from AaE via their notified email address
- approved credits will be processed through this settlement system
- IATA charge codes (per TACT rules, section 6.2) are used to define any miscellaneous fees in the report
- similar process has operated for a number of years successfully with IATA CASS participants in the United Kingdom
