# Award Categories

## 1: Liner Trade to Asia Award (incorporates former North, East and South East Asia Awards):

For on-time performance and outstanding customer service for lines or joint services on the Australia – Asia Trade Routes.

2008 WINNER: NEAX Consortium (MOL, NYK, KLINE)

## 2: Liner Trade to Rest of World (incorporates former Europe, Mediterranean and US Awards):

For on-time performance and outstanding customer service for lines or joint services on the Australia – Rest of World Trade Routes.

2008 WINNER: CMA CGM, Marfret, ANL

## 3: Green Transport Award:

Formerly the Good Corporate Citizen Award, this category still recognises leadership in creating economic, social, and environmental sustainability in individual businesses, the so-called “triple bottom line”, but now also incorporates environmental safety. The award may be given for management and monitoring systems, which measure targets in economic, social, and environmental goals, or for practical examples of leadership either in the community or with other industry stakeholders.

2008 WINNER: AirRoad

## 4: Safe Transport Award:

Occupational Health and Safety is an important aspect in any workplace. In industries such as transport and logistics, where heavy goods move at an ever-faster pace, regularly interacting with the workforce, the possibility of an accident is always there. This award will be given to the company seen to have introduced effective safety measures, which have produced demonstrable improvements in occupational health or safety.

2008 WINNER: Patrick Terminals

## 5: Innovation in Security Award:

The award will be given to an Australian-developed system that has improved operation, or cut the cost of security in ports or aboard ships in port. The award can be made for new or adapted technology, innovative use of outside technology, innovations in management or administration of shipping, or a port that achieves a major improvement in security.

2008 WINNER: Port of Brisbane Corporation

## 6: Port or Terminal of the Year Award (2008 Sponsor – Svitzer Australia):

Now well established as a prestige award in the Australian maritime industry, this award has, over the years, recognised excellence in both specific port/terminal development projects, overall management achievements and commercial successes. The theme for this award changes each year, and has included environmental protection, management of port/urban/transport interface, and technical innovation in projects.

2008 WINNER: Port Kembla

## 7: Training and Education Award:

To be presented to the company or institution or organisation with the best proven record in training either recruits, young staff or established staff for work in the international trade and transport sectors. The award may go to a public educational establishment or a commercial or in-house training scheme.

2008 WINNER: Victorian Department of Innovation, Industry and Regional Development

## 8: Transport and Logistics Intermodal Award:

This Award recognises achievement in the door-to-door movement of cargo/freight, using high levels of integration between different types of transport such as sea, rail, and road. The award can go to an individual shipping line or freight forwarder for a common user intermodal service, or for a transport solution which they have customised for a particular user or cargo. The award could also be given to a dedicated intermodal facility or for a specific piece of technology – be it cargo handling technology, or software that improves the management of intermodal operations.

2008 WINNER: Logwin Air and Ocean

## 9: Freight Forwarder of the Year Award:

This award is for companies displaying excellence in freight forwarding, in terms of service and efficiency in sea, air, road or rail freight.

2008 WINNER: DML Global Forwarding

## 10: Maritime Services Award:

For exceptional achievement or contribution to any service sector of the Australian maritime industry by a company, individual or organisation. Open to agents, brokers, classification societies, legal, finance, telecommunications or IT suppliers.

## 11: New Generation Award:

An award for a person under the age of 35 working in any sector of the Australian maritime or transport industry deemed to have made special contribution to his or her industry during the past 12 months.

## 12: Seafarers Welfare Award:

A special award to a company, organisation or individual seemed to have made an outstanding contribution to the welfare of seafarers.

## 13: Newsmaker of the Year:

This award goes to the person deemed by the editorial staff of Lloyd's List DCN to have had the most newsworthy impact on the transport and logistics industry in the past year.

## 14: The Trade and Transport Hall of Fame Award (2008 Sponsor – Sydney Ports Corporation):
