Valued Clients,

We are experiencing robust volumes at DP World Sydney. This throughput combined with recent weather stoppages and unfortunate equipment outages are causing spiralling delays and all time high yard density. This is thereby limiting our ability to get ahead of these impediments to terminal productivity. In order to overcome the same we will be introducing the following measures effective Wednesday 27th October;

1. All services will have export receivals of four (4) consecutive working days before and inclusive of the cut-off day. Working days are Monday to Sunday inclusive. Vessel receivals opened prior Wednesday 27th October will remain at five (5) days.
2. Late receivals will only be accepted for rural rail exports.

We appreciate that these measures may cause some inconvenience, however, we consider that this is warranted given the current operational setbacks at DP World Sydney. We will continue to monitor the situation and advise all clients.
