### Electronic Reporting of House Air Waybill Data for Shipments to South Korea

Effective from 01 December 2011, customers will be required by South Korean customs to supply electronic master (FWB) and house air waybill (FHL) data for all shipments destined for or transiting through South Korea.

FWB and FHL information must be completed and transmitted to Qantas Freight or our Ground Handling Agent at origin, prior to lodgement of consignments destined for South Korea.

Your shipment may be delayed and additional fees may be applied to any shipment lodged without an electronic FWB or FHL.


If your in-house system does not have the capability to send FWB or FHL data, registered users in Australia may use the free facility provided at [qantasfreight.com](http://qantasfreight.com). Similar facilities may also be available through local Ground Handling Agents for customers outside of Australia.

FWB and FHL information is already a customs requirement for shipments to the following countries:

- United States
- Malaysia
- India
- Canada
- Indonesia
- China
- United Kingdom
- Europe (EU)
- Korea

FHL information should not be sent for shipments to other destinations.
