CLEAR FLOAT GLASS EXPORTED FROM THAILAND, THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA

Measures

Anti-dumping measures have been imposed on clear float glass exported from Thailand, the Peoples Republic of China (China) and the Republic of Indonesia (Indonesia).

Description of the goods

The clear float glass covered by measures is:

- in nominal thicknesses of 3 to 12 mm;
- transparent;
- flat;
- rectangular or square in shape.

The Australian Industry Standard nominal thicknesses and thickness tolerances apply and are contained in Table 1.

The acceptable Goods subject to measures should be classified using the tariff sub-headings and associated statistical codes contained in Table 2.

Exempt exporters

There is one exempt exporter of clear float glass from China: Xinyi Ultrathin Glass (Dongguan) Co Ltd (Xinyi). Exemption type “SUPPLIER” applies to clear float glass manufactured and exported by Xinyi only. All other exporters are subject to anti-dumping measures as advised in Table 4 below.

Dates of Effect

Anti-dumping measures were initially imposed on 17 October 2011.

Identifying the goods subject to measures

Glass with the following characteristics is not covered by the anti-dumping measures:

- coated, coloured, tinted or opaque;
- absorbent, reflective or non-reflective layer;
- wired;
- bent, edge-worked, engraved, drilled, enamelled or otherwise worked;
- framed or fitted with other materials;
- toughened (tempered) or laminated;
- acid etched; or
- low iron.

Direction for collection of interim dumping duties

Goods subject to the measures must be entered using the relevant dumping specification number (DSN) for the nominated exporter/supplier as shown in Table 3.

The interim duty rates and the ascertained export price (AEP) for each DSN are shown in Table 4.

The amount of interim dumping duty (IDD) payable shall be:

- the amount equal to the IDD rate per square metre shown in Table 4; plus
- the amount, if any, by which the dumping export price (DXP) is less than the AEP shown in Table 4.

Release of details of measures

The interim duty rates and the ascertained export price (AEP) for each DSN in Table 4 are considered Confidential and will not be published.

Bona fide importers of the goods may be provided with the confidential information relevant to a nominated exporter/supplier. Unless an importer is able to demonstrate a trading history with the nominated exporter/supplier, no confidential information for that exporter/supplier will be provided.

Where no prior pattern of imports exists, evidence of an offer, quotation or acceptance of an order from a nominated exporter/supplier is considered the minimum requirement before confidential information relevant to that exporter/supplier may be disclosed.

Customs will conduct monitoring of imports consistent with its published policy.
