1. The Dangerous Goods Code is now mandatory. The morning presentation is concerned with packaged dangerous goods, implementation of the IMDG Code, problems that have been encountered when it has not been followed and what those in the transportation chain can do about it. It is particularly intended to raise awareness of issues in applying the Code.
2. The afternoon seminar gives an update on the Security situation with specific reference to the recently published ILO code of practice on security in Ports. It will include a discussion on the state of play on maritime security in Australian Ports.

The new revised ILO Code of Practice on Safety and Health in Ports. This third edition of the ILO CoP was published 1 February 2005. The presentation will concentrate on the content of the new Code, it's relationship with the ILO Convention on Safety and Health in Dock Work and its scope and implications
