



Fuel Tax Credits Scheme Reforms - VTA Workshop

Thursday, 8 June 2006



The Victorian Transport Association (VTA) invites you to a special Workshop to hear from experts on the Fuel Tax Credits Scheme reforms due to be introduced from 1 July 2006.

The current Energy Grants Credits Scheme (EGCS) expires on 30 June 2006, and new rules will apply from 1 July 2006 for companies claiming fuel tax credits for "on-road" use of fuel.

Significant changes relate to eligibility for fuel tax credits (i.e. removal of the metropolitan boundaries allowing urban vehicles between 4.5 tonne and 20 tonne GVM to claim, and the introduction of emissions performance criteria for eligible vehicles), as well as the method for claiming.

This is an opportunity to discuss the fuel tax credits reforms with representatives from Government, including the ATO and DoTARS

- Claiming through the Tax System – how will this be done?
- Emissions Performance Criteria – how best can I comply?
- Record Keeping – what do I need to do?
- "Greenhouse Challenge Plus" - do I need to join this Federal programme to qualify for fuel tax credits?
