



We have been advised by Australian Customs Service that a large number of industry haven't registered a Type 3 Digital Certificate.

If you are planning on submitting Air Cargo Automation, Sea Cargo Automation or Customs Declarations through Deliverance or EdiEnterprise after 12th October 2005, you will need a Type 3 Digital Certificate as part of the Imports Phase of Cargo Management Reengineering (CMR).

Everyone using our software will require one (1) Type 3 Certificate per EdiEnterprise or Deliverance installation.

If you did register a Type 3 Digital Certificate for Exports, please ensure that you check the expiry date and renew it as necessary. You will not need another Type 3 Certificate as it will work for Imports. However, this does not apply if you are migrating from Deliverance to EdiEnterprise. Sites migrating from Deliverance to EdiEnterprise will need a new Type 3 Certificate that is setup for EdiEnterprise using a different email address.

If you did not purchase a Verisign Type 3 Digital Certificate as part of the Export CMR cutover, you should be registering with Verisign and getting a Type 3 Certificate NOW. Please go to our website and download our CMR Checklist.
