**Urgent Deadline for Domestic Cargo Security Measures Document
Updated Information**

Dear Regulated Agent,

You may be under the mistaken understanding that if you follow the procedures in your current international program you do not have to develop a *Domestic Cargo Security Measures* Document.

If you wish to handle any domestic air cargo after 10 March 2005 you must answer the questions in the *Domestic Cargo Security Measures* document. You must clearly outline how your business achieves the outcome listed in each question. If a question does not apply to your operations please answer not applicable and explain why.

You must keep your *Domestic Cargo Security Measures* document on your premises and continue to comply with it and your model program. The deadline for sending notification to Department of Transport and Regional Services that you have completed this document or that you only handle international air cargo is 24 February 2005.

If we do not receive notification from you by 5.00pm 9 March 2005 you will not be able to handle or make arrangements for domestic air cargo without developing a full Transport Security Program.
