COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT NOTICE - 2004/12

QUARANTINE APPROVED PREMISES – CLASS ONE SEA AND AIR FREIGHT DEPOTS SCHEME

ACCREDITATION EXTENSION

As you will be aware, all persons currently accredited under the Quarantine Approved Premises – Class One Sea and Air Freight Depots Scheme should be in possession of an accreditation certificate with an expiry date of 30 June 2004.

This notice is to inform industry that this **accreditation** for the Quarantine Approved Premises – Class One Sea and Air Freight Depots Scheme has been extended until further notice. This extension is due to the need to finalise the review of the Quarantine Approved Premises – Class One Sea and Air Freight Depots Scheme, prior to any re-accreditation process being undertaken.

All persons currently accredited under the Scheme (with the exception of those accredited within the previous 6 months) will be required to undertake re-accreditation training during 2004, however, at this stage no dates have been set for the re-accreditation training. AQIS is in discussions with the AQIS and Industry Cargo Consultative Committee to confirm details for the re-accreditation training.

Further notification will be distributed to industry once information relating to the re-accreditation training is available. In the meantime, please ensure that all accredited persons working to your business are made aware of the extension to their accreditation.
