CMR Upgrade of ediEnterprise

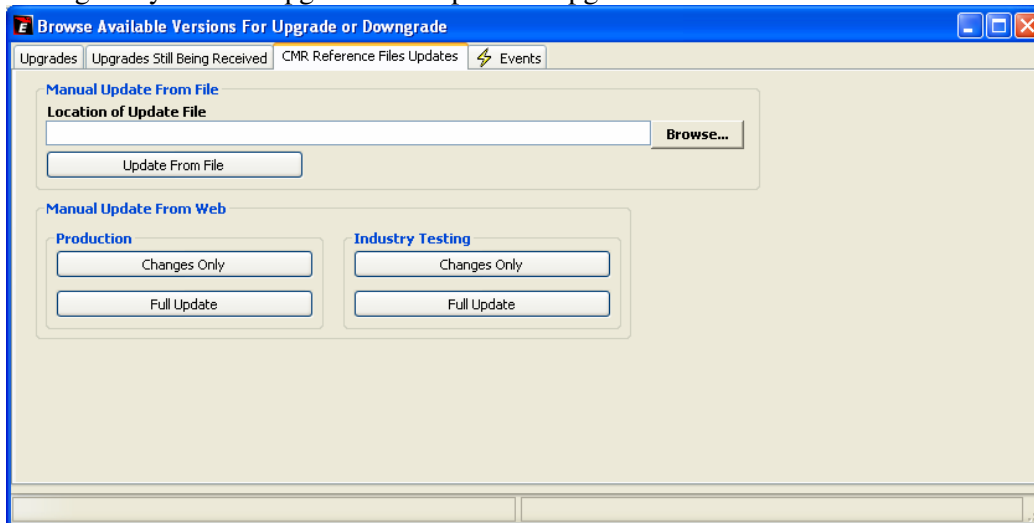
Summary

This update note provides important information that you need to know before you can use ediEnterprise for CMR. The Reference File Update section only applies if you use Import Customs Declaration module.

Description

Reference File Update

In order to start using ediEnterprise's Customs Declaration module for CMR, you will have to import CMR reference files first. To import CMR reference files, Go to Config -> System -> Upgrades and open the Upgrade form as shown below.



Click Manual Update From Web -> Full Update if this is the first time you import CMR reference file. If you want to import changes only, click on Changes Only.

Depending on internet connection, the update may take more than 5 minutes. While this update is running, users should NOT use Customs Declaration module.

While updating, the machine running the update must have Internet connection, as ediEnterprise will be downloading files from Customs website. If you experience any problems downloading reference files. You can manually download them from the following links:

Full Production Update:

NOTE: Currently you will have to update reference files **DAILY**, so that your Exchange Rates will be updated correctly each day. This means that before anyone can use Customs Declaration module each day, someone with Security access to the Upgrade module must update the reference files first.

If you do not have a dedicated staff to do the reference file update each morning, then you may need to give security rights to each broker to access the Upgrade module, so that any one of them may update reference files at the beginning of each day (refer to staff security instructions in the Installation Guide). You need to ensure that when giving Upgrade module access, that you do not give out other System level security rights unintentionally, i.e. only tick the box to grant Config->System->Upgrade module access on the Group or individual Staff form's Security tab.

Once this is done, if you want to send messages from old jobs that were created before the CMR reference file update in CMR Mode, then you need to reset the old jobs to original to generate CP Dec questions.

Supplier and Importer Codes

Supplier and Importer codes, IID and SCC, are removed and replaced by CID – Customs ID. CID needs to be setup for each supplier and Importer through the Organisation Form's Config tab.

If you do not have CIDs in your system yet, you can go to http://itools.customs.gov.au/registered_ccid.php and enter the old EDIFICE code to find the new CMR code. An upgrade dated on or after "06-OCT-05 15:54" will do this code change automatically for you.
