Dear Customer,

As you are aware Qantas Freight, over the past few years, has implemented and withdrawn fuel surcharges as the price of aviation fuel has moved.

Over the past few months, the price of aviation fuel has progressively increased to a point where Qantas Freight needs to implement a further surcharge. Effective 01st June 2004 the following AUD fuel surcharge will apply.

- 1) For all General and Express Cargo ex Australia:- AU\$0.25 per kilo.
- 2) For Perishable Cargo ex Australia – lodged as built up units ready for carriage:

Type 5:	AU\$375.00 per unit
Type 6:	AU\$250.00 per unit
Type 8:	AU\$175.00 per unit
Loose lodged perishable cargo:	AU\$ 0.25 per kilo

- The surcharge will be calculated on the actual weight on the air waybill.
- The surcharge will be non-commissionable.
- The amount must be shown on the air waybill under the “Other Charges, Due Carrier” box with the code “MYC”.

We will continue to monitor the price of fuel and will adjust the surcharge accordingly.
